第7問 次の英文を読み、あとの問い(A・B)に答えなさい。

Today, we often see Shohei Otani on TV. He hits many home runs and also *pitches very well. People call him a “two-way player.” Do you know there was another great two-way player in America about one hundred years ago? His name was George Herman Ruth, and his nickname was “Babe Ruth.”

George Herman Ruth was born in 1895 in *Baltimore, America. His family was very poor. His mother was often sick, and his father was busy working. No one could take care of him and teach him how to *behave, so Ruth became a bad boy. He didn’t listen to adults and did a lot of bad things.

When he was seven years old, he was sent to *St. Mary’s Industrial School for boys. It was a *reform school for boys who got into trouble. There, he met a kind teacher, Mr. Matthias. Mr. Matthias was good at baseball and taught the boys how to play it. Ruth loved baseball and learned a lot from Mr. Matthias.

At first, Ruth played as a catcher. One day, he laughed at the pitcher who didn’t play well during a game. Mr. Matthias got angry at Ruth’s rude *behavior and said to him, “Can you pitch and show us you are better than him?” Ruth did, and he was very good. *From then on, he became a pitcher. He got better and better and became one of the best pitchers in Baltimore.

When he was 19 years old, he became a professional baseball player. In 1914, he joined a team called the Baltimore Orioles, and the next year, he moved to the Boston Red Sox, a Major League team. He started as a pitcher and won four games in his first year. He worked hard and became a popular player.

Ruth also liked hitting. Most pitchers didn’t practice hitting, but he did. Some of his teammates laughed at him, but he didn’t care. He practiced a lot and became a great hitter. In 1919, he hit 29 home runs and broke the Major League record at that time.

After that, Ruth moved to the New York Yankees. There, he hit many home runs. In 1927, he hit 60 home runs in one year. It was an amazing number. In total, he hit 714 home runs during his 22-year *career.

Ruth was not only a great player but also a kind person. He loved children. When he saw poor children who couldn’t buy tickets to games, he bought tickets for them. He visited *orphanages and reform schools. He gave money to help them. He remembered his own hard *childhood and wanted to help other children like him.

Even after he became an adult, Ruth often acted like a child. He didn’t always know how to behave in restaurants, hotels, and trains. He didn’t learn it when he was a child. People thought Ruth looked and acted like a big baby and they called him “Babe.”

Babe Ruth was a bad boy when he was little, but he grew up and became a great baseball

player and a kind person. He gave many children hope and dreams. He died in 1948, but people still remember him as one of the greatest players in baseball history — and the first big two-way player.
