On September 19th, 2019, all of Japan was excited. The Japanese national rugby football team won a game against *Ireland. It surprised and excited not only Japan but also the whole world, because Ireland was the best team in the world at that time, and Japan was only the 10th. The miracle happened in the 2019 Rugby World Cup *qualifying league held in Japan.

The captain of the team was Leitch Michael. He is from New Zealand. He was born in 1988 in Christchurch, a city on the southern island of New Zealand. He started playing rugby there at the age of five, because his mother liked rugby very much.

When he was fifteen, he came to Japan as an *exchange student and studied at a private high school in Sapporo. Of course, he played rugby there. However, the Japanese way of practicing rugby was very hard for him and he often wanted to give up, but people around him always *encouraged him. His coach, his teammates, and his host family always supported him, so he loved Japan very much and decided to keep playing rugby here.

In 2009, he was chosen as a member of the Japanese national rugby football team, and five years later, he became captain of the team. There were many foreign players on the team. They were from different countries and different cultures, so they had different ways of thinking. It was very difficult for them to play rugby as a team. Leitch Michael told them over and over again how important it was to work together as a team. He did a lot of unique things to *make them act like a team. For example, he taught the members of the team about Japanese history and culture. He and his teammates took time to learn about each other's cultures. Then, in 2019, they became A TEAM and made a miracle. They won the game against Ireland, the best team in the world.

We should not forget another reason why the Japanese national rugby football team won — their hard work. They trained hardest in the world. The Japanese players were smaller than the players from the other countries, so they needed to be faster. They also had to be *tougher. Their head coach, Jamie Joseph, told them to do the hardest training in the world, and they did. The Japanese national rugby football team became very fast and tough. Leitch Michael supported the team through their training. They believed that their hard work would lead them to *victory, and it did.

Leitch Michael says, "We should have a dream. It is important. We should have a goal. It is more important." He believed that and made a miracle which surprised and excited the whole world.
